Dig It! Monroe UMC FRIDAY NIGHT Volleyball at 7 pm:

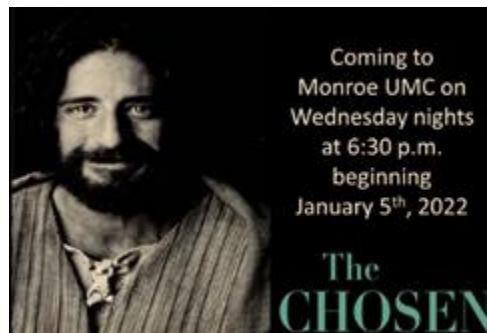
